Born on February 3, 1912 in Zagorze, Poland, she endured the challenges of Nazi occupation and then Martial Law under Communism until she and Wiktor, moved to Oakland California in 1990. She traveled occasionally to the east coast to visit family and friends in Connecticut, and often to Poland from whence she came. She lived life to the fullest enjoying the occasional Reno or Las Vegas casino trip, fine dinners with friends, and weekly telephone check-ins with friends and family around the globe. She is predeceased by husband Wiktor Klin and by her daughter Grazyna.
