**G**eorge Martin Ahern March 28, 1921 - July 24, 2009 George Ahern passed away peacefully in the presence of his family on July 24 at the age of 88. He was a third generation Oaklander, attending Saint Francis de Sales Grammar School, University High School, University of California Berkeley and Harvard University. He served in the U.S. Navy during World War II where he became a Lieutenant Commander. He worked as a stock broker in Berkeley until the age of 79 and was an active member of several civic and community organizations including the Berkeley Breakfast Club, the Berkeley Lions Club, and the Serra Club where he made countless life-long friends. He leaves behind his beloved wife of 64 years, Louise; his three children Carol Andersen, Tom and Gail Ahern and son and daughter-in-laws Richard Andersen and Beverly Ahern; and seven grandchildren Kean, Heather and Scott Ahern, Michael and Kristen Andersen, and Megan and Nicholas Hoff.
