# Leonard G Ambrose

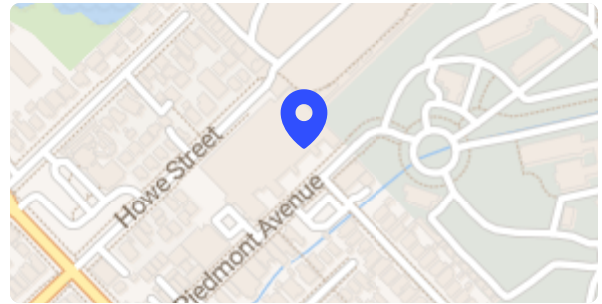

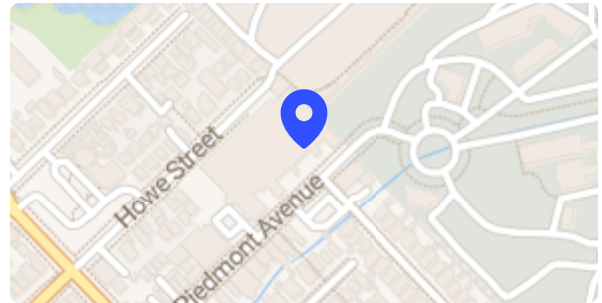

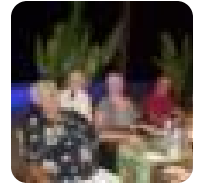
