Mimi was also a member of Eta Kappa Nu, an engineering honors society. During summers, Mimi worked at Lockheed in 1985 and at FMC in 1986. Mimi graduated in December 1986 and then started her employment with Altera Corporation where she stayed for 20+ years working as a software engineer.

In middle school, Mimi became a Christian, and attended Bay Area Chinese Bible Church (BACBC) and continued to serve in several ministries as her faith grew. She served as Sunday School teacher, Vacation Bible School teacher and Deaconess.

Mimi had a passion for everything Disney and took the opportunity to go to Disneyland as often as possible. She was also an avid Oakland A's and the Golden State Warriors fan and a collector of A's and Warrior player bobbleheads. 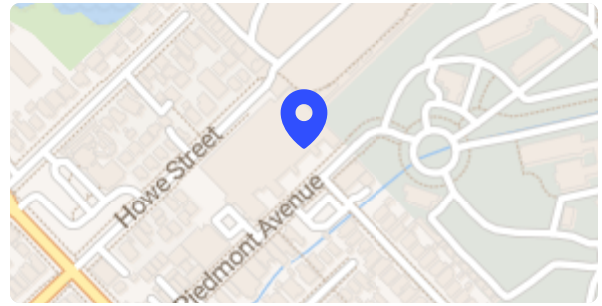
