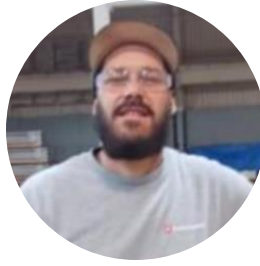

In Loving Memory of Justin Westmoreland

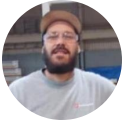
October 29th 1987 – January 17th 2025

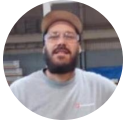

A celebration of his life will be held this summer at his sister's house, where family and friends can gather to honor and remember him.

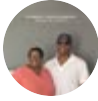
Rest in peace, dear Justin Westmoreland. Your love and legacy will live on in our hearts forever.

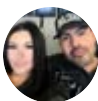

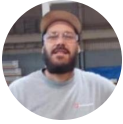
